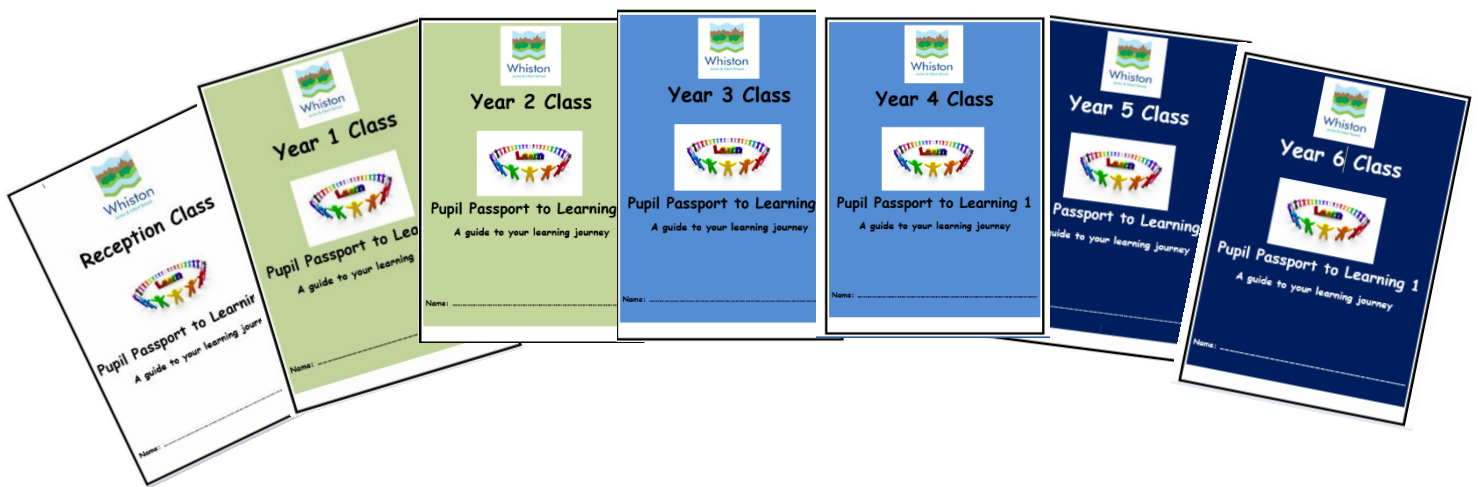


Pupil Passports to Learning
