Thank you for your interest in the residential for next September.

This year the residential is for 2 ½ days and during their stay children will have the opportunity to participate in many activities included water based activities such as raft building and canoeing. Other activities may include: 3G swing; abseiling; archery; campfire; climbing; buggies; zip wire etc – see Parent's Welcome Guide for more information.

Payment information:

The cost of the 2 ½ days at Dearne Valley is £157.00.
The coach for the return journey is an additional £10.00.
Total £167.00.

A **non-refundable** deposit of **£50.00** (to secure a place) is due by **Monday 28th January 2019**
A second payment of **£50.00** is due on **Monday 8th April 2019**
A final payment of **£67.00** (inc coach) is due on **Friday 12th July 2019**.

Day of residential:

On Wednesday 20th September, children will need to access school through the Breakfast Club door between 8:40 - 9:30. This will allow time for you to talk to school staff to discuss any medical issues etc.

The children will then spend the morning in their classroom and they will have lunch as normal. At approximately 1:30pm, the children will leave by coach to the Kingswood site, where they will stay until their return around 2:30pm on Friday 20th September 2019.

If you would like your child to participate in the residential, please **complete** and **return** the slip below to school and then **give your consent and make payment of a £50.00 deposit** via the **School Money system** no later than **Monday 28th January 2019**.
